Playground Policy

To avoid injuries on the playground children are required to follow the playground rules: *Children below the age of thirteen (13) must be supervised at all times, including while they are on the playground. The playground areas are open for play during daylight hours. To avoid injuries these areas are prohibited at 9:00 p.m. or dark, whichever comes first.*

Lawn Maintenance

Please assist the maintenance staff with maintaining the lawns and remind children not to leave wrappers and debris on the playground and surrounding area. It is your responsibility to remove bikes, children's toys, grills and other outside items from the lawn. Non-compliant residents will be tagged and the items will be removed at the resident's expense. Any flowerbeds that are not being properly maintained by the residents will be mowed down.
